Shopping for home appliances can be inspiring if the new \$5 million Miele Gallery at Hilton is anything to go by.

In the designer showroom, Miele's premium domestic appliances share floor space with an array of work by local artists.

Miele cooking appliances, refrigerators, dishwashers, coffee machines, laundry and floor care products are inventively displayed alongside commissioned art pieces such as Jan Irvine-Neale's detailed fabric and stitching work which symbolises SA's landscape.

Other artworks include Sean Diamond's commissioned light painting photography work, Peter Coad's vibrant landscapes and works by artists of the Yorke Peninsula's Narrunga people and the Western Desert region.

Well-known Narrunga artist Irene O'Loughlin, now living interstate, has painted a series of seasonal works specifically for the gallery featuring Wardang Island in Spencer Gulf and the sand hills near her home town of Point Pearce.

The new gallery also has a well-equipped kitchen which is used for complimentary cooking classes to demonstrate how to use Miele's H5000 series cooking appliances.

Miele Gallery was built by Adelaide-based Candetti Construction with interior design by Australian architectural company RBI Architecture.
